












Tree removals planned for Redvers Street Surrey Hills

Tree location	Tree species	Reason for removal	Image
1 Redvers St	<i>Prunus cerasifera</i> (Cherry Plum)	Weed species, poor health poor structure. Expect some agapanthus to be removed to enable stump grinding.	
2 Redvers St	<i>Platanus x acerifolia</i> (London Plane)	Poor health, poor structure. Dieback of twigs in outer canopy.	
5 Redvers St	<i>Prunus cerasifera</i> 'Nigra' (Purple-leaved Plum)	Poor health, poor structure	
6 Redvers St	<i>Eucalyptus nicholii</i> (Narrow-leaved Peppermint)	Good health and good structure, but leaning towards private property. Council arborists have monitored the degree of lean annually over the past three years. The lean toward properties is slowly increasing, so we need to remove the tree.	

Tree location	Tree species	Reason for removal	Image
15 Redvers St	<i>Eucalyptus lehmannii</i> (Bushy Yate)	Poor health, poor structure. The tree is in decline with dead outer branches and multiple epicormic shoots growing from all structural branches, especially in the middle of the tree. While the epicormic growth creates bushy canopy, this will continue to grow up into the low voltage electric lines.	
19 Redvers St	<i>Hakea salicifolia</i> (Willow-leaved Hakea)	Poor health, more than 50% dead. Arborist assesses that the tree can be removed without affecting the adjacent <i>Acacia floribunda</i> .	
21 Redvers St	<i>Eucalyptus lehmannii</i> (Bushy Yate)	Poor health, poor structure. The tree is in decline with dead outer branches and multiple epicormic shoots growing from all structural branches in the centre of the tree. While the epicormic growth creates bushy canopy, this will continue to grow up into the low voltage electric lines.	
23 Redvers St	<i>Prunus cerasifera</i> 'Nigra' (Purple-leaved Plum)	Poor health, poor structure	

Tree location	Tree species	Reason for removal	Image
Adjacent 24 Redvers St	<i>Eucalyptus nicholii</i> (Narrow-leaved Peppermint)	Good health but poor structure. Removal of epicormic shoots growing up to service wire will leave limited canopy. Expect some removal of agapanthus to enable stump grinding.	
30 Redvers St	<i>Prunus cerasifera</i> 'Nigra' (Purple-leaved Plum)	Poor health, poor structure	
30 Redvers St	<i>Prunus cerasifera</i> 'Nigra' (Purple-leaved Plum)	Poor health, poor structure	
32 Redvers St	<i>Acacia implexa</i> (Lightwood)	Good health, fair structure. Tree offers limited canopy. Removal of both trees at 32 enables one larger tree to be planted in the centre of the nature strip.
